- Experience in daily reporting to management
- Excellent communication and advisory skills
- Must have a current, valid driver's license
- Must be eligible to work in the United States
- Must be able to pass a drug test and background test

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct field safety/audit inspections
- Suggest to workers proper safe work practices
- Identify and coordinate safety improvement plans to ensure the continuous improvement of safety in new and existing products, processes and procedures
- Enforce OSHA policies (e.g., accident reporting process)
- Maintain and apply knowledge of current health and safety policies, regulations and industrial processes
- Identify and correct potential hazards by inspecting facilities, machinery and safety equipment
- Maintain all OSHA required programs, training, logs, records and reports
- Partner with Client in accident investigation procedures
- Keep records of safety-related incidents and propose corrective actions
